

What's the big deal about lead poisoning?

- Lead sickness does not always cause symptoms we can see
- Lead can permanently harm the brain and nervous system
- Lead can cause learning problems, attention problems, and behavior problems
- Lead can sometimes cause speech and hearing problems and slow down growth


What can FCC providers do?

Remove any lead in the home

- Use wet paper towels to clean up dust with lead
- Clean around windows and play areas
- Wet mop floors
- Wash hands and toys with soap and water
- Use duct tape to cover chipping or peeling paint

Key Points

- Lead exposure can harm young children and babies even before they are born!
- Even children who seem healthy may have dangerous levels of lead in their bodies
- Encourage FCC providers to check if there is a risk of lead exposure in their homes


